What is a series & grade?

Series and grade is the Federal Government's system for categorizing and defining jobs. The series is a numbered system for grouping similar occupations. For example, a Nurse is part of the 0610 series. A 'grade' refers to the General Schedule (GS) pay scale - it's the pay level for the job. The higher the grade level, the higher the pay.

What is a general schedule grade?

General Schedule Grade is based on education, training, general work experience and specialized work experience. These educational requirements are laid out by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM). There are 5 main career groups with different educational requirements: Competitive Service Student Trainee Positions.

What are the GS grades?

Here's a general breakdown from USAJOBS on the GS grades: GS 1 - 4: Requires a high school diploma and little to no work experience. GS 5 - 7: Requires entry-level experience or an educational degree. GS 7 - 11: Requires generalized experience in the field or advanced educational degrees.

What GS level do I qualify for?

If you're wondering what GS level you qualify for, you're not alone. The General Schedule (GS) is the pay scale for most federal jobs, ranging from GS-1 to GS-15. The GS system classifies positions based on experience, education, and expertise. It is also used to determine your pay grade and potential promotion within the federal workforce.

How are GS jobs classified?

Each agency classifies its GS positions and appoints and pays its GS employees filling those positions following statutory and OPM guidelines. The General Schedule has 15 grades--GS-1 (lowest) to GS-15 (highest). Agencies establish (classify) the grade of each job based on the level of difficulty, responsibility, and qualifications required.
